This event will consist of panel led and group discussions that will seek to answer questions on these topics:

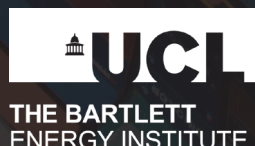
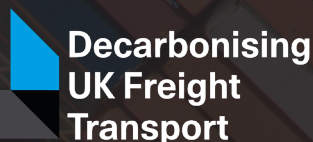
- The nature of decisions investors are making today, that have an effect on decarbonisation
